SUBJECT: COUNTY MEDICAL SERVICES PROGRAM (CMSP)
FISCAL YEAR 2013-14 SECOND HALF ELIGIBILITY ALLOCATION

Enclosed with this letter is a table presenting the County Medical Services Program (CMSP) Eligibility Administration Allocations for the second half of fiscal year (FY) 2013-14. Counties should receive payment for their second half Eligibility Allocation by the end of December.

The allocation for the second half of FY 2013-14 was calculated based on CMSP enrollment for the period of January – June 2014.

As in previous years, the FY 2013-14 allocation takes into consideration the following:

- Counties with case error rates at/below 5% receive a 5% increase in their county eligibility allocations;
- Counties with case error rates above 5% up to 10% receive their full eligibility allocations; and,
- Counties with case error rates above 10% receive a 5% decrease in their county eligibility allocations.
- Counties with case error rates above 15% for two or more consecutive years receive a 5% reduction for each year greater than 15%
