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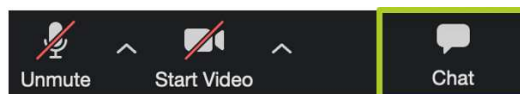

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## CMSP Overview



The County Medical Services Program (CMSP) was established in January 1983 as a dedicated program for smaller rural counties to provide health care services to uninsured indigent adult residents

The CMSP Governing Board is charged with overall policy and fiscal responsibility for CMSP.

CMSP's 35 participating counties include:

Alpine, Amador, Butte, Calaveras, Colusa, Del Norte, El Dorado, Glenn, Humboldt, Imperial, Inyo, Kings, Lake, Lassen, Madera, Marin, Mariposa, Mendocino, Modoc, Mono, Napa, Nevada, Plumas, San Benito, Shasta, Sierra, Siskiyou, Solano, Sonoma, Sutter, Tehama, Trinity, Tuolumne, Yolo, and Yuba.

## HID Grant - Purpose



The CMSP Governing Board seeks to help CMSP counties and non-profits contracted with CMSP counties develop expanded physical capacity to provide healthcare and behavioral health services to underserved populations including CMSP beneficiaries.

## HID Grant - Description



HID Matching grants provide a portion of the locally required match for a primary grant that has been received by an eligible county department within a CMSP county, intended to expand physical healthcare infrastructure within the county.

## HID Grant - Award Amounts

Grant awards are available to CMSP counties as follows:

- For a single county, the lower of \$500,000 or a 5% match of the total project cost;
- For two or more counties collaborating on one grant, the lower of \$1 million or a 5% match of the total project cost.
- Only 1 grant will be awarded per CMSP County.





## **HID Grant - Eligible Applicants**

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The following county organizations may apply for a HID grant:

- Health Departments
- Public Health Departments
- Behavioral Health Departments
- Health and Human Service Agencies

In addition, these county organizations may apply on behalf of a non-profit organization in the CMSP county that is under contract with the county for the delivery of health or behavioral health services that has received a federal, state, or other grant for healthcare infrastructure development that requires a local financial match.



## **HID Grant - Target Population**

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With this grant, the Governing Board seeks to address the needs of underserved populations in CMSP counties, including CMSP beneficiaries.

Underserved populations may include but are not limited to:

- CMSP Beneficiaries
- Uninsured or underinsured adults
- Uninsured or underinsured children
- Medi-Cal, Medicare or Covered California Members
- Individuals who traditionally lack access to health or behavioral healthcare



## **HID Grant - Eligible Facilities**

Qualifying HID Grant facilities will be new or expanded facilities that provide one or more of the following types of services:

- Healthcare Services
- Public Health Services
- Mental Health Services
- Alcohol/Drug treatment Services

Facilities funded by a HID Grant shall be used for their intended purpose for the entire period required under the federal, state or other grant received by the county or a non-profit under contract with the county.

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## **HID Grant - Application**

The application is a 3-page fillable PDF that asks for:

- Applicant county & department information
- Non-Profit information (if applicable)
- Counties Served
- Amount requested
- Target population
- Planned services
- Project description
- Primary funder information and required match
- County Board of Supervisor Letter of Commitment



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## **HID Grant - Sample Project**

A CMSP County Behavioral Health Department received notice of award for a \$4.1M Behavioral Health Continuum Infrastructure program (BHCIP) grant. Their BHCIP project plan is to expand both physical capacity and treatment options at the county contracted non-profit SUD treatment center which currently operates only on an outpatient basis.

Following completion of the project, the newly expanded facility will continue to offer outpatient services and will additionally offer adult residential SUD treatment of up to 90-days. Facility expansion will include a furniture refresh in the current group meeting rooms and a new 4,000 sq ft wing with 15 residential beds and kitchen & bath facilities needed for inpatient services.

The center serves one CMSP county. Their BCHIP Award requires 10% local match.

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## **HID Grant - Sample Project**

### **Should this county apply for a HID Grant?**

They have an eligible entity (Behavioral Health) performing an acceptable project (facility expansion) providing acceptable services (Alcohol/Drug Treatment) and that received a state grant (BHCIP) which requires local match. **Yes, they should apply!**

### **Who should be on the application?**

The county should list themselves as the applicant. Additionally, they should note the department and non-profit they are applying on behalf of.

### **How much funding should they request?**

The RFA states maximum award for facilities serving one county is the lower of 5% total project cost or \$500,000.

Their total project cost is expected to be \$4.1 million.

5% of \$4.1 million = \$205,000

**They should request a HID Matching grant of \$205,000.**

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## HID Grant - Timeline

January 2023 - RFA Released  
Applications accepted on a rolling basis

CMSP Governing Board Meeting Dates  
May 25, 2023  
July 27, 2023

June 30, 2023 - Submission Period Ends

The submission period may be extended.

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## Application Instructions

- Applications must be complete at the time of submission and on the form provided on the CMSP website.
- The application must be signed by a person with legal authority to obligate the Applicant.
- Include the signed Letter of Commitment from the County Board of Supervisors as separate attachment.
- Do not provide any materials that are not requested.
- Submit the completed application, and attachment, in one email by **June 30, 2023**, to [grants@cmspcounties.org](mailto:grants@cmspcounties.org)



The submission period may be extended.

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## Q & A - Common Questions

### **What kinds of services can be provided at facilities supported by the HID Matching Grant?**

Any type of health care services - public health, mental health, SUD, oral or vision - may be provided at facilities supported by HID Grants.

### **Do grants for non-physical health or behavioral health infrastructure improvements, such as accreditation efforts, building rehabilitation, and IT upgrades, qualify for HID Matching Grants?**

HID grants are intended to support physical expansion only and may not be used to fund other infrastructure development initiatives.

### **How many awards will be granted per CMSP county?**

Only one HID Matching Grant will be awarded per CMSP county, either for a qualifying county effort or a qualifying effort of a non-profit provider in the county.

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## Q & A - Common Questions

### May a county apply for a HID Matching Grant to meet financial matching requirements for a primary grant funding a new mobile health clinic?

A mobile health clinic is a physical form of facility infrastructure intended to increase healthcare/behavioral healthcare capacity. As such, new mobile health clinic projects would qualify for HID Matching Grant funds if there is a local financial match requirement.

### Can applicants use HID Matching Grant funds to meet financial match requirements on other CMSP grants?

No. HID Matching Grants may not be used to meet the in-kind matching requirements of other CMSP grants.

### When will award notifications be sent out?

Applications must be submitted by June 30, 2023, and will be presented to the CMSP Governing Board for consideration during its regularly scheduled meetings. Notifications will be made following the meeting at which a proposal is presented to the Board.

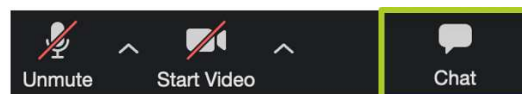
